

COOKIE POLICY

A cookie is a file that is sent to request permission to be stored on your computer. Once accepted, the file is created and the cookie is then used to obtain information about web traffic and to make future visits to a recurring website easier. Another function of cookies is that they allow websites to recognise you individually and therefore provide you with a more personalised service.

Our Website uses cookies to identify the pages visited and how frequently they are visited. This information is used solely for statistical analysis and is then permanently deleted. You may delete cookies from your computer at any time. However, cookies help websites provide a better service; they do not provide access to information on your computer or about you unless you choose to provide that information directly. You may accept or refuse the use of cookies. However, most browsers accept cookies automatically because this helps provide a better web service. You can also change your computer settings to refuse cookies. If you refuse them, you may not be able to use some of our services.

Website cookies:

Cookie name: Google Analytics

Description/Purpose:

Google Analytics cookies generate an anonymous user ID that is used to count how many times a user visits the Website. They also record the first and last time the Website was visited and calculate when a session has ended, the user's source and keywords.

Cookie name: Cookie Notice

Description/Purpose:

To recognise the user so that the cookie notice is no longer displayed. If the user accepts the policy, the notice will not be shown again for 60 days.
